



**LAW SCHOOL EXTERNSHIP PROGRAM
(One semester: Fall 2019 or Spring 2020)**

Under the close supervision of Colleen F. Coonelly, Laurel House Director of Legal Services, enrolled students provide civil legal assistance to clients escaping violent relationships and seeking protective orders, child custody and child support.

Only second - and third - year students who have obtained Certified Legal Intern status under Pa. B.A.R. 321 (the student practice rule) from their law school will be considered. In addition to the intern assignments described above, externs will assume the role of lawyer in court, pursuant to the rule. Ms. Coonelly serves as Supervising Attorney under that rule. At each school's discretion, students dedicate a set number of hours per week (typically twenty) for academic credits (typically seven). Interested students must obtain law school approval and must submit, by **4/19/19 for the fall 2019 semester or by 9/20/19 for the spring 2020 semester**, a cover letter; a resume, two references with email addresses and phone numbers, and a writing sample to:
