Students must have completed their first or second year of law school. Interns will have exceptional training and the opportunity to learn and develop skills in domestic violence and family law. Assignments include legal research and writing; drafting briefs and other court documents, preparing intake forms; reviewing, analyzing and summarizing cases; and interviewing clients and witnesses. Interns will also gain practical experience through shadowing attorneys at meetings and court appearances. Internships are unpaid.
