WHY WOULD ABUSED PERSONS SEEK OUT DOMESTIC ABUSE COUNSELING?

The scars of domestic abuse are usually deeper than those from other types of trauma. Prolonged abuse that occurs in the home, the place where we are supposed to feel safe, leaves a profound impact. Brief or short-term counseling is usually not enough.

The impact of domestic abuse on children is a serious and, too often, an unaddressed concern. Counselors and advocates are available to non-offending family members to help them assess the impact on the children and provide suggestions and resources to help them address their specific worries.

Counseling services are also available to youth, ages 14 and older in abusive dating relationships, or to address the abuse in their families.
