FRIENDSHIP FUNDAMENTALS (6TH-7TH GRADE)

- Ways to maintain healthy friendships
- Differences between healthy/unhealthy friendships
- Helping a friend in need
- Identifying resources and safe people to turn to for help

HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS (8TH-12TH GRADE)

Students will learn about:

- The influence from media (social media, tv shows, movies, etc.) within relationships
- The importance of boundaries
- Differences between healthy/unhealthy/abusive relationships
- Warning signs of unhealthy relationships
- Helping a friend in need
- Identifying resources and safe people to turn to for help
